# WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO?

Last year's fundraiser enabled our 501(c)3 all-volunteer nonprofit to:

#### Maintain pastures, fields, meadows, and trails

- Maintain our Hawk Hill Farm pastures, Stout Family Fields, and Evans Family Meadows.
- Work with the town to promote Lisa Lane Farm community gardens and to improve the LaSalette Trail.
- Purchase a brush hog to use with our rebuilt 1955 John Deere tractor. This enabled us to do some of the mowing and trail maintenance with volunteers at reduced cost.

# Support The 4 Five Farm's operations at Hawk Hill Farm

• Install new signage along the walking trail. This allowed the public to use the Farm's trails during the growing season without interfering with the farmer's operations.

#### **Conduct educational outreach events**

- Present webinar "Gardening for Bees, Butterflies and other Pollinators" at WLT Annual meeting.
- Conduct "virtual" nature hikes on CT Trails' Day and co-sponsor fall sociallydistanced hikes with the Town of Bloomfield.
- Co-sponsor with Bloomfield Leisure & Senior Services 2020-2021 a free seven webinar **Nature Series** with professional speakers.
